Short history



The Lamb of God Evangelical Ministry of Haiti is a ministry founded in 1983 by Pastor Daniel Mulatre. father of six children, 3 boys (Samuel, Smith, Elie) and 3 girls (Daniella, Ifonise, Aliette) with his wife Cécile Merana. After he received God's call, he did his first evangelization work in Lassaire, a zone in the North-East department of Haiti, where he implanted the first church called Lamb of God, on the first Sunday

of August 1983. After a few years, God asked him to leave the northeast to go to the north where he settled permanently, specially at Bahon. Continues his ministerial work, he implanted a second Lamb of God church at Bahon in 1985. This municipality connects 3 other areas. In his ministerial work, he also implanted a church in each of them (Bois-pin, Bailly, Montagne noire). From then on, Pastor Daniel has 5 churches and 2 schools under his responsibility with different leaders on each churches. Pastor Daniel is a servant of God who has a lot of experience in the evangelical world. In his work of development, he has set up a small school in each church to help the weakest Because at that time, there was a need for education in Haiti. But for economic reasons several of them have closed only Lassaire and Bahon exists. With the power of God ministry grow up every day. For some years, the man of God has suffered from diabetes and Parkinson's disease, which has prevented him from continuing his work as before. God chose one of His son Smith to continue the ministry.

Who is pastor Smith



I am the fourth son of Pastor Daniel, the second boy in the family. I have been a part of this ministry from a very young age as a musician, maestro, youth leader, Sunday school monitor. I studied Agronomy at the North Christian University of the of Haiti, and start to work with Joy and Hope of Haiti a Canadian organization to teach vegetable garden for kids in

different school, and then Assistant manager in the same organization. After I feel desire to study theology. After so much resistance, I went to the Biblical Seminary at Biblical Seminary of Hope in Cap-Haitian. Actually I hold a Master's degree in Biblical Theology from Baptist University of Florida. I am married to Carline Célicourt, God has not given us a child yet. After graduating in Agronomy, I started a vocational school within the ministry to help young people have a manual job on behalf of the Christian Institute of Northern Haiti (ICFPN) from which, several cohorts of students received their professional diploma. When Pastor Daniel called me to say I'm going to take over the ministry for him, I felt a little confused, because my older brother is a pastor. I was asking the question why you don't choose my old brother. He told me with a short answer no it's you. I didn't accept this offer because It was in my eyes that I saw my father's sufferings in the ministry. After a long time in prayer I felt different than before, I am starting to have new feelings for the ministry and I say to my father let's me help you with one of the churches, he said as you are young you have more energy than me go to Lassaire. Lassaire is located in high of the mountain and every day I feel happy to serve people there. Now with my father's illness, especially Parkinson, the entire ministry rests under my responsibility.

Purpose of Lamb of God Evangelical Ministry

The purpose of this ministry is the advancement of the kingdom of God, as announced by Jesus Christ, which is characterized by public worship, the preaching of the gospel, the study and application of the word of God, the Christian and faithful conduct of its members, evangelism, missionary, and social work.

Goal of Lamb of God Evangelical Ministry

Our goal is to develop each area where our institution is located, spiritually, socially, and economically. We have noticed the major problem of the country's lack of governance. We cannot change it, but we can change our locality.

Current Ministry Overview

Lassaire Ministry, North East Department



Lassaire is the mother of all the institutions of the ministry. it is a mountainous area. It was founded first in August 1983. Funny coincidence I was born in September 1983. It has a large primary school about 400 students from kindergarten to 6th grade. Founded in the year 2000 after seeing the necessity to educate the children of the area. Before that, the children need to walk 5 to 10 kilometers every day to go to school. In 2016, the Joy and Hope of Haiti the organization that I worked, accept my request to help us with teachers and kids. The organization pay teachers, and employees and give soup for kids twice a week. If you look at pictures you can see the old building with 4 classrooms and the new building with 5 others classrooms finish with Joy and hope organization. In this school we have 9 teachers, 3 direction members, and 8 small staff.

What we are looking for now?

- 1. Drinking water. We are in 2025 our kids and all people drinking water from uncovered water source.
- 2. Solar Energy system for school to help training. In 2025 our teachers and kids don't know anything in technology. If we have a solar system, it will allow us to use materials to facilitate and improve teaching.
- 3. First aid center for kids and the other peoples in the zone. Specially for the pregnant wife. When someone has fallen ill in the area, you have to walk 5 8 kilometers to find a first care hospital. The area has no road for carriage, people have used animals (horse, donkey) for transportation or a motorcycle. That is to say we have a necessity for a first aid center.
- 4. A vocational school to help young people with a manual Job. For this, we already have the local disponible, because of the school. The primary school operates from 8 o'clock in the morning to 1 o'clock in the afternoon, we can

use the rest of the day for vocational training. We only need the financial means to pay qualified professionals for teaching and to purchase the necessary materials for education. We are already considering: fencing, office computing, electricity, plumbing, tiling, carpentry, agricultural technique, sewing and so one...

Mompoint Ministry: North Department



Mompoint is an area located in the communal section of Bois-Pin in the municipality of Bahon. It is a mountainous area of high altitude. This institution was established after conducting an evangelization tour during which many people accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior in 2001. We deemed it necessary to start this ministry to provide people with a place to worship the Lord. Three years ago we began the construction of the temple, but it is still unfinished. We are looking for funding to complete this construction for the glory of God. We have a budget of 15,000 dollars to complete this construction. As you can see pictures above we need help for the roof, cilling, doors, walls, benches and paint.

Cap-Haitian Ministry: North Department









This church is the youngest of our institutions. Founded in 2023 in Cap-Haitian, the center of the North department, near the airport. All our churches are concentrated in the marginalized areas of the country. We deemed it necessary to establish this church in the city of Cap-Haitian through prayer. Currently, this church operates in a garage in the yard of one of the faithful. We already have a space to build it. We are looking for available funding for that.
